His goal is to work in the mining industry and build a house for his mother.



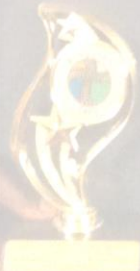

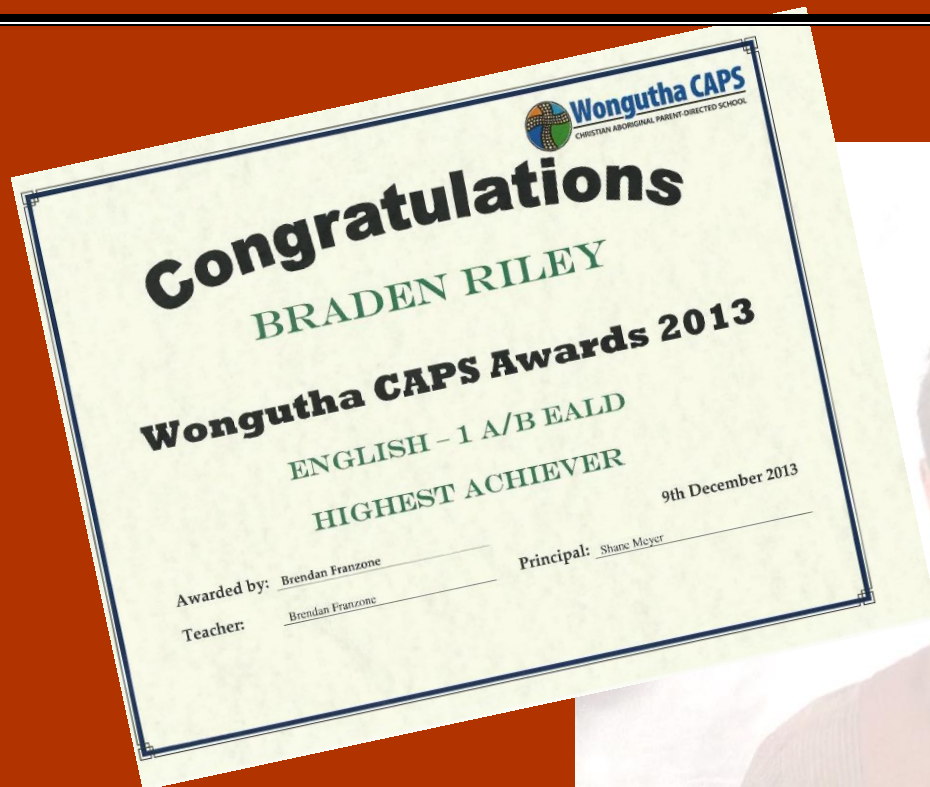
